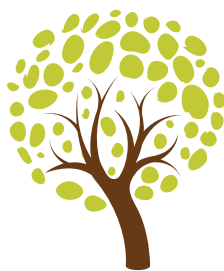

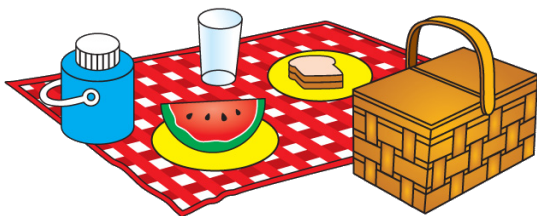

SUMMER SAFETY TIPS

Summer is right around the corner!
Tioga County Public Health wants our families to have fun and be safe with our Summer Safety Tips!

When participating in any wheeled sport, it is important to wear protective gear. **ALWAYS** wear a helmet and bright-colored clothing!

When children are swimming, an adult should be present. Always check the water area before play!

To prevent bug bites, it is important to use insect repellent. Bugs may transmit harmful diseases!

Use sunscreen with at least 15 SPF protection when going outdoors. Drink plenty of water and do not forget to give plenty of water to pets!

NEVER leave children and pets in parked cars, even with the windows opened. Just 60 seconds in the car can be deadly!

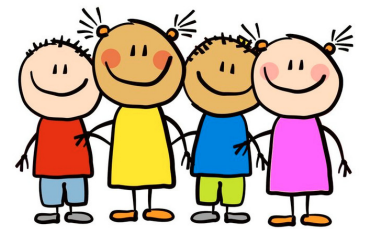
