TIOGA COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE – APRIL 30, 2020

Owego, NY – Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported the following Tioga County COVID-19 Statistics:

- 98 Confirmed Cases Total confirmed cases, to date.
- **69 Individuals in Mandatory Quarantine.** These are individuals who have had close contact (6 ft.) with someone who has tested positive, but is not displaying symptoms for COVID-19; or individuals that have traveled to China, Iran, Japan, South Korea, or Italy and is displaying symptoms of COVID-19.
- **1** Individuals in Precautionary Quarantine. These are individuals who have traveled to China, Iran, Japan, South Korea, or Italy while COVID-19 was prevalent, but is not displaying symptoms; or is known to have had a proximate exposure to a positive person but has not had direct contact with a positive person and is not displaying symptoms.
- **31 Recovered** Total number of individuals who had a confirmed case of COVID-19 and are now symptom and fever-free that meet the criteria to be released from Isolation.
- 10 Deaths

This is a snapshot of data provided to Tioga County Public Health at this point in time. Administered tests are tracked in various ways. Test results are reported.

Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported *Tioga County Mental Hygiene Owego Clinic* remains open Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and is providing services remotely by telephone and telehealth (video); remotely offering new Intake Assessments (Mental Health and Alcohol & Drug Services), health assessments, individual therapy, psychiatric medication management, Suboxone management, crisis services, and face-to-face services as necessary.

The *Waverly Clinic* remains open Tuesday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. for remote therapy and medication management services.

After hours crisis remains available by phone after 5:00 p.m. weekdays and on weekends by calling 607-687-1010 and asking for the on-call mental health social worker.
