The Public Hearing on Local Law Introductory No. C of 2006 A Local Law amending Local Law No. 4 of 1989 A Local Law providing for the collection of a hotel/motel tax in Tioga County was called to order by the Chair at 1:34 P.M. All Legislative Members were present.
