**RESOLUTION NO. 248-06 BACKFILL FULL-TIME
E911 DISPATCHER
SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

WHEREAS: Tioga County Resolution 211-99 requires legislative approval for any appointments made above an established base salary amount; and

WHEREAS: A vacancy for a full-time E911 Dispatcher exists and has been budgeted and approved for backfill; and

WHEREAS: The Sheriff would like to fill this budgeted position with Elizabeth Struble, an individual who has prior experience with the department; and

WHEREAS: Ms. Struble is fully trained with First Responder & EMD certifications and possesses knowledge of established policies and procedures as an E911 Dispatcher with Tioga County; and

WHEREAS: The Sheriff has approval from CSEA to hire an experienced E911 Dispatcher at the higher starting salary of \$25,786; and

WHEREAS: The Tioga County Sheriff's Office and the Personnel Department have found Elizabeth Struble willing and eligible for such appointment to said position; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Tioga County Legislature hereby authorizes the backfill of one vacant full-time E911 position with the appointment of Elizabeth Struble at an annual salary of \$25,786 effective 10/20/06.
