 - o Perhaps work on advertising
 - o Ideas:
 - Red Door in Waverly has active recovery groups there
 - Perhaps get it started at that site
- Club House
 - o Staff person hired to run Club House part-time
 - o Kids ages 11 and up are eligible
 - Must be sober to participate
 - o After school program from 2:30-6pm three days a week
- Joshua's House relaunch event well attended by kids and families
