New York State Public Health Law requires that all puppies and kittens get their first rabies shot at three months of age. They also need to get a booster shot at one year old and then again every three years. Ferrets must get a shot every year. Pet owners who fail to maintain current vaccination may receive a fine of up to \$200 per animal. Bring any past rabies shot records.
