RECYCLE

Continue to recycle and take materials to the recycling center or put them on the curb



SAFETY

- Keep sidewalks, driveways and private lanes clear of snow and ice to help workers stay safe
- Drive carefully and cautiously around recycling trucks and workers especially during poor road conditions



RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

Winter storms can create power outages. Prevent waste by using rechargeable batteries rather than disposable ones



VISIBILITY

- Make sure your recycling collector has a clear view of and easy access to your recycling bin
- Do not place your recycling bin behind snow banks so collectors can see them



SECURE RECYCLING

Place heavier items on top of lighter items to prevent papers from blowing away
