Public Hearing Annual Agricultural District Inclusion March 7, 2019

The Public Hearing on requests of inclusion of viable agricultural land in agricultural districts received within the designated time period in 2019 was called to order by the Chair at 1:01 P.M. Seven Legislative members were present with Legislators Monell and Standinger being absent.

The land is currently being used for grain and maple syrup production so it is viable agricultural land. The Ag and Farmland Protection Board has met and recommends to the County Legislature that this modification be approved."
