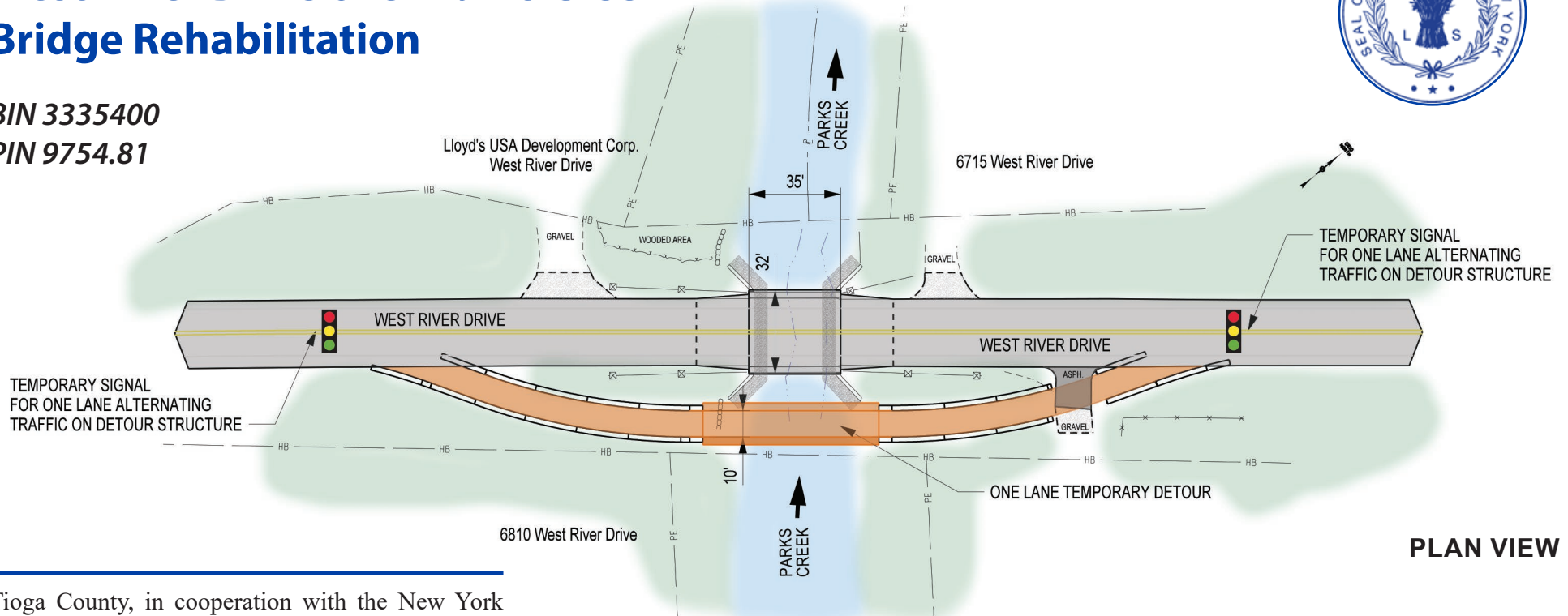


West River Drive over Parks Creek Bridge Rehabilitation

Tioga County, in cooperation with the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is in the process of developing preliminary plans for the rehabilitation of the West River Drive Bridge over Parks Creek in the Town of Nichols.

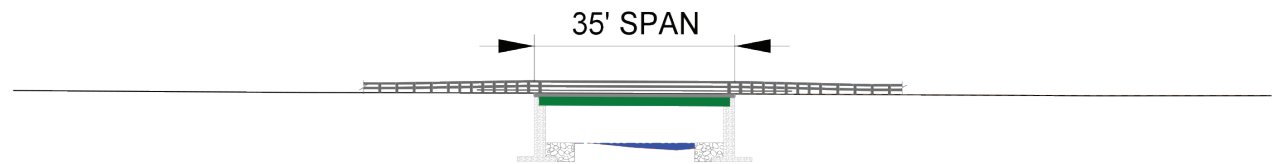
This federally funded project proposes to replace the existing concrete deck with a new concrete deck supported on the existing beams and existing concrete abutments. The steel beams will be cleaned, repaired as needed and painted. The replacement deck will be slightly wider than the existing bridge and will include 11 foot travel lanes and a larger 3 foot – 4 inch wide shoulder to replace the existing narrow safety walk. During construction, vehicles will be detoured on site using a temporary bridge to the south of the existing bridge. Pavement on West River Drive within the project area will be resurfaced.

The estimated construction cost for this structure is approximately \$541,000. Construction is anticipated to begin in Spring 2020 and be completed during the 2020 construction season.

This informational flyer is being distributed as part of the continuing efforts by NYSDOT, FHWA, and the Tioga County Department of Public Works to

encourage public input into the development of transportation projects.
