

Broome - Tioga Stormwater Coalition Presents:

Contractor Erosion & Sediment Control Training

The Broome -Tioga Stormwater Coalition will be holding a 4-hour Erosion and Sediment Control Training for

Contractors, Developers, Engineers and any individuals involved in soil disturbance activities.

Under the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation's Stormwater Permit, all developers, contractors and subcontractors must identify at least one *trained individual* from their company that will be responsible for implementation of the SWPPP, and have at least one *trained individual* on site on a daily basis when soil disturbance activities are being performed. Also, developers must have a *qualified inspector* conduct regular site inspections in accordance with the construction general permit.

Qualified inspectors and trained individuals must have 4 hours of training in the principles and practices of erosion and sediment control endorsed by NYS DEC, SWCD, or CPESC Inc. Training is good for 3 years.

Training is **not** required for CPESC, LA, and PE certified persons.
