COVID-19 UPDATE - DECEMBER 7, 2020

Owego, NY – Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported the following Tioga County COVID-19 Statistics:

- **1,285 Confirmed Cases** – Total confirmed cases, to date.
- **496 Individuals in Mandatory Quarantine** - These are individuals who have had close contact with someone who has tested positive, but is not displaying symptoms for COVID-19; or individuals who traveled outside of New York State.
- **1,038 Recovered** – Total number of individuals who had a confirmed case of COVID-19 and are now symptom free that meet the criteria to be released from isolation.
- **183 Active Cases**
- **64 Deaths**

This is a snapshot of data provided to Tioga County Public Health at this point in time. Administered tests are tracked in various ways from various locations.

With great sadness, Tioga County Chairwoman Sauerbrey reports the loss of two additional lives and expresses our sincere sympathy to the families and friends.

Chair Sauerbrey reports these two new deaths are from non-nursing homes. The increases continue to be through community spread. Everyone is encouraged to continue wearing masks and social distancing.
