 - Sold as a weight loss/antidepressant
 - Pseudo opioid highly addictive as short as two days
 - Withdraw lasts up to two weeks
 - Will not register on a drug test

- Found at headshops
- Jars are \$ 25-\$45
- Narcan does work
- Already banned in Massachusetts and Kentucky
 - Perhaps should do a public service campaign
- Porshea is currently on three different boards
 - The Red Door Waverly
 - Hoping to put in apartments women above the Red Door
 - Received a grant to do small upgrades
 - Lockwood Church "Another Door"
 - May be used as sober housing
 - Parking lot is being put in
 - Shawn told Porshea about a connection he has who may be able to assist her group with what they are trying to accomplish

 - Purpose is to talk it thru in the event of a real incident
- Coroner Bob Williams
 - One coroner had an overdose death
 - Toxicology still out as to the drug used
- RSS Larissa Brower
 - Currently RSS has openings and accepting referrals
 - Larissa will be out after February on maternity leave
- Pat Gillule
 - Retired from teaching this past June
 - Remains the Director of Camp Badger
- Shawn Nalepa
 - Retired from the Tioga County Sheriff's Department in June
 - Currently working as an instructor in Broome County
- Other Discussion
 - Housing and the homeless population discussion ensued
 - Shawn shared there is a large number of homeless people in Broome County.
 - 60-70 kids in the Endicott School System

- 300+ in the Binghamton School System
- Everything is being turned into student housing in Broome
- People everywhere are being priced right out of housing
- Porshea shared about some of the people she is meeting and trying to help on a daily basis
- Tioga County has no homeless housing
- Section 8 has a two-year waiting list; homeless has priority
 - Difficulties with navigating this system shared
